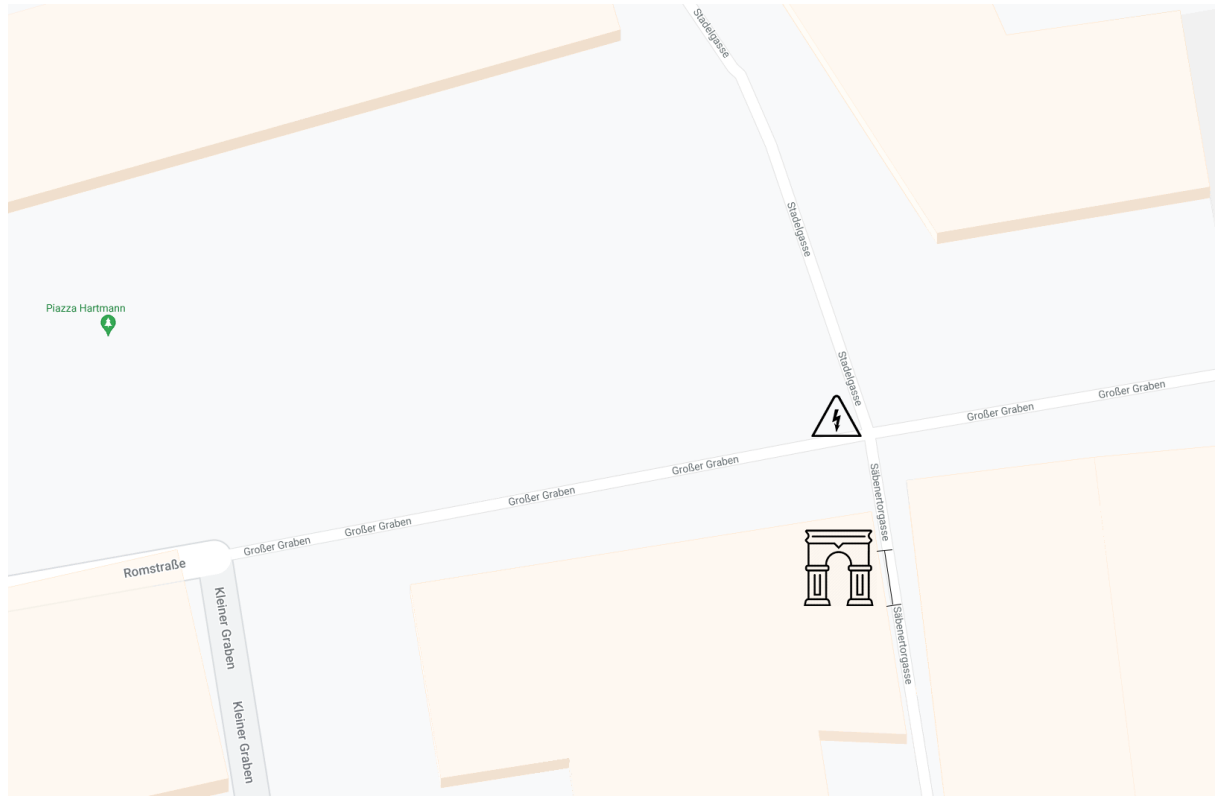

Get to know the location

At the end of the Große Lauben, the Säbenertorgasse leads north to the Säbener Gate and the Großer Graben. The northern city gateway with a Gothic hipped roof, named after the Lords of Säben. From the 17th to the 19th century, it was also called the “Stadeltor” (Barn Gate) or “Bräuhaustor” (Brewery Gate). Originally part of the Säben-Lachmüller manor house which today houses the Eisacktal District Community. It is interesting to note that the gate tower, which has been renovated several times, is still preserved in its original Gothic form with the shooting windows.
