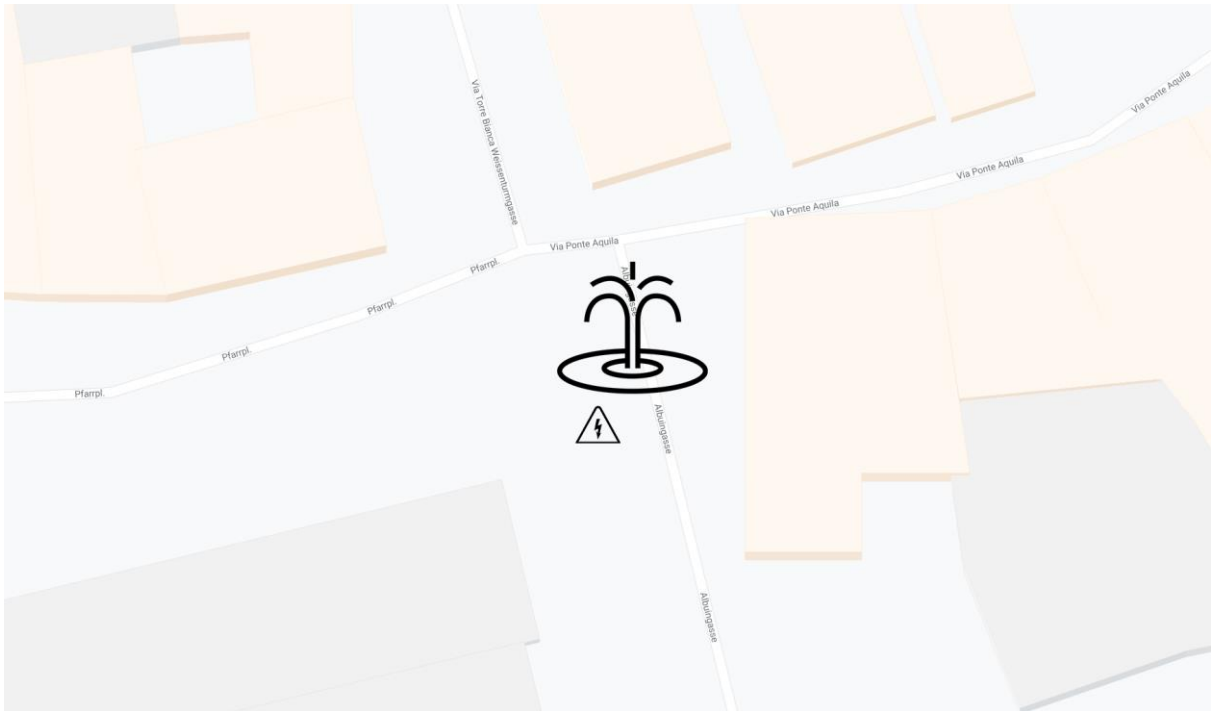
There is a fountain where Adlerbrückengasse and Weißenturmstraße join Albuinstraße and meet at the White Tower. The first fountain in Brixen with running water was located by the White Tower. That is why the Fischbänke, the fish market where the fish brought into the city was sold, were located there as well. On occasion of the city's 1,050th anniversary celebrations in the autumn of 1951, Albuinstraße alley was redesigned, and a new fountain was erected at the White Tower and inaugurated on 28 October 1951. On its column stands the bronze figure of the Archangel Michael slaying the dragon. St. Michael has the task of protecting the parish church dedicated to him and the nearby St. Michael's Gate, as well as accompanying dying people on their way. The White Tower itself is the landmark of the city. It was built around 1300, the belfry was enlarged in 1459 in the Gothic style. The octagonal masonry pinnacle, which gives it its name, dates from 1591.
